

C-DORYS have been designed to cruise extremely well at speeds from 7-20 knots, and may be driven well above 20 knots in flat water. The hull design is based on the time proven New England semi-dory types. The broad planning surface aff is most efficient and the sharp entry forward reduces pound to compare with deep V types.

Bottom design also permits the hull to ride at a near level attitude at all speeds. The entire bottom of the C-DORY has a fiberglass encapsulated core (¾" min.) giving them great rigidity and making them suitable for beaching. These boats are exceptionally stable and have good walk around decks. The molded in plank lines serve as excellent spray knockers, sending the bow wave out in flat sheets. They also greatly stiffen the sides with no increase in boat weight. Being quite light for their length, C-DORYS offer real economy of operation, with considerable improvement over deep V types of comparable length.

All models are of hand laid fiberglass, striping of hulls and color accents on decks are of gelcoat applied in the mold. The accent stripe on the top is acrylic enamel. No color tape or decals are used for color trim. All gelcoats have ultraviolet screens and an additional black ultraviolet screen under the gelcoat for extra protection from the harmful effects of the sun. All models have molded in non-skid surfaces on their decks, they will not peel up like the glue on

The 16', 18' and 22' share the same construction method and mechanical systems. They are of one piece fiberglass construction. Hull, house, decks and top are all glassed together in the mold to insure a perfectly aligned structural ioint. This one piece construction eliminates squeeking, leaking joints. All decks are heavily cored for an extremely rigid gunnel that easily accepts extra cleats, down riggers, rod holders, pot puller or commercial mast and rig. Commercial open skiffs can be custom built to meet your fishing/utility needs.

All models are available direct from the factory. Wholesale pricing on Johnson Outboards and E-Z Loader Trailers make it possible to supply high quality, complete packages at affordable prices. Your C-DORY will be built to order, so you get a "new" boat freshly hand built.
