Bridges along the canal

Five draw bridges including the Burlington Northern Railway cross the ship canal. Signal one long blast (4 seconds) followed by one short (1 second) at least 100 yards from bridge tender to open. The bridge tender will answer with 1 long and 1 short if the bridge can be opened, or 5 short if it cannot. On weekdays all bridges remain closed during rush hours—7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. (*Montlake bridge closes at 3:30 p.m.)

For more information and nighttime openings call 206-720-3048 for Montlake bridge and 206-386-4251 for Ballard, Fremont and University Bridge. Vertical clearances at center are given below bridge names.



Passing through the Locks

The locks are open 24 hours unless closed for maintenance. Actual locking time averages 20 minutes for the large lock and 10 minutes for the small lock. Waiting time can be up to several hours. Red and green lights signal when you can enter. Make sure fenders are placed on both sides and station someone on the bow and the stern with 50' mooring lines with 12" eyes spliced into one end. Listen to lock attendants for instructions. Free classes are offered as well as a booklet, *Guidelines for Boaters*, by calling the lock master at 206-738-7000.

SPEED LIMIT THROUGHOUT CANAL IS 7 KNOTS

The Locks to Webster Point is approximately 5.5 nautical miles. Use chart 18447 for navigation and bridge clearances.

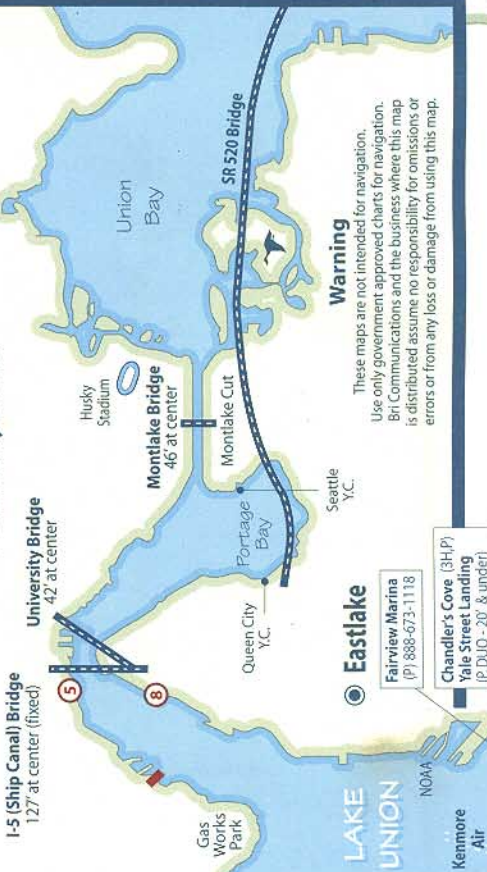
